Now that we have reached the end of the induction phase of the new term, I want to thank parents for their support in ensuring a smooth start to the New Academic Year.

I am delighted to welcome 133 new Year 8 pupils to the Sperrin College Community, moving the school enrolment to almost 700 pupils. I want to thank parents for their unwavering support which has enabled the school growth. This development is linked to the outstanding academic outcomes achieved by Year 12 and Year 14 pupils at GCSE and A Level. At GCSE we saw an outstanding 99.1% 5 A* - C pass rate, with 85% 5 A*-C including English and Mathematics. At A Level there was more success with 87% of students receiving 3 A*-C grades. We were thrilled to be able to acknowledge that success at our recent Prize Event.

Looking forward to the New Academic Year, I want to inform parents of some changes to staffing. Mr Nigel Small has been appointed as a second Vice Principal joining Mrs Chambers. Mrs Kellie-Marie Martin has left Sperrin College as she has been appointed as Vice Principal in Oakgrove Integrated College. We wish her every success in her new role.
