Items required are as follows:

- Blazers
- Shirts

- Skirts
- School Jumpers
- Ties - Junior, Senior & Sixth Form
- PE Kits - T-Shirts, Hoodies, shorts/skorts



All items received will be redistributed for free from the school building on the following dates:

- Thursday the 28th of July from 11am-7pm
- Friday the 29th of July from 10am-3pm

Parents/Guardians are encouraged to phone in advance to check availability of items.

We are also aware that many parents/guardians will also be purchasing new uniform items. Please note that our official suppliers are **Sportique and Cuddy's, Magherafelt**. These are the only businesses with access to our uniform.

School Ties:

Parents/guardians are reminded that pupils in Years 8-10 wear our navy striped tie. Years 11 & 12 wear our navy crested tie and Sixth Form boys wear our teal crested tie.

School Shoes:

The graphic below outlines the type of shoes pupils are permitted to wear. Please note that trainers, converse, vans and similar items are not permitted, even if they are all black. **Please do not purchase these items.**
